WISCONSIN STUDENTS ARE UNRELENTING IN THEIR EFFORTS TO PASS COMMON SENSE GUN LEGISLTION

On August 4th, Wisconsinites will march to say enough is enough

MADISON, WISCONSIN, JULY 26th — MarchOnNRA Wisconsin is currently drafting legislation that includes, but not limited to, universal background checks, reinstituting the 48-hour waiting period, raising the age to purchase a firearm to 21, campaign finance, and more. Legislation will be reintroduced by MarchOnNRA Wisconsin and state legislators in the current session and next session until passage. MarchOnNRA Wisconsin is inviting all members of the community to help lobby these bills in the state legislature.

Student Organizer Max Prestigiacomo said, "As students, we grow up learning about the values of a good Democracy and a representative Government. Now that I am of an age to see the reality of our political system, I have noticed that the values I was taught are not reflected in our Democracy. On August 4th, I plan to call out what it—by definition—really is: an Oligarchy."

Student Organizer Sophie Guthier said, "It is important that we keep our fight intersectional and realize that gun violence comes in many forms including in our police forces." The march focuses its issues on not just one form of gun violence, but all forms.

Speaker Chloe Baumbach said, "How is it that schools have been deemed a "safe space" where students are supposed to be able to escape the fears and stressors of home, yet students now fear for their lives?" If politicians don't list to these voices, it's likely students will elect ones that do in November.
